On Friday Oak class will need their P.E kits, they will be taking part in P.E at school.



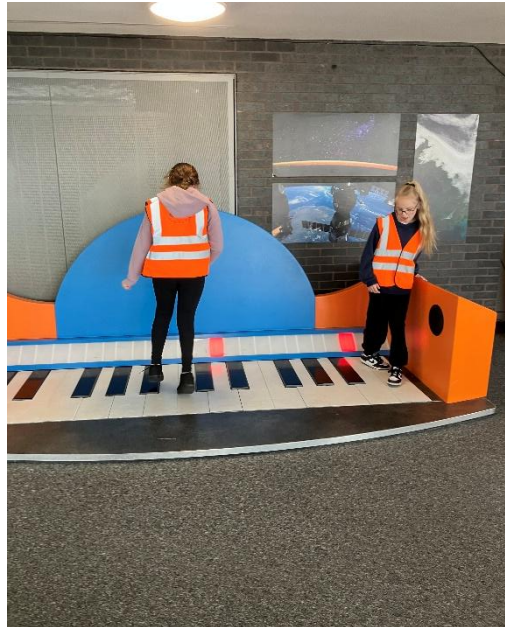

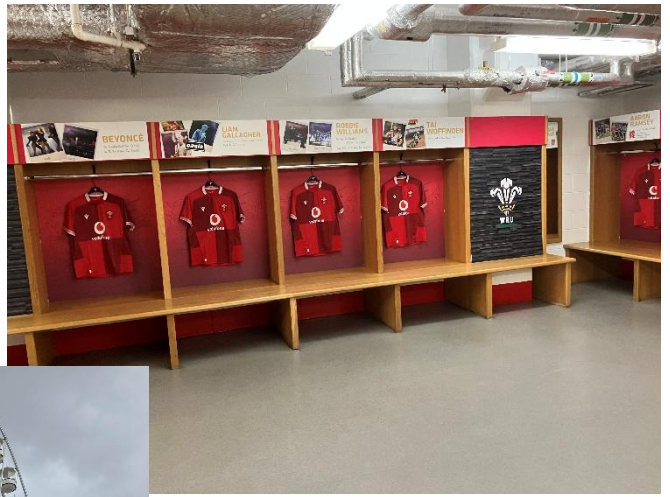

Residentials

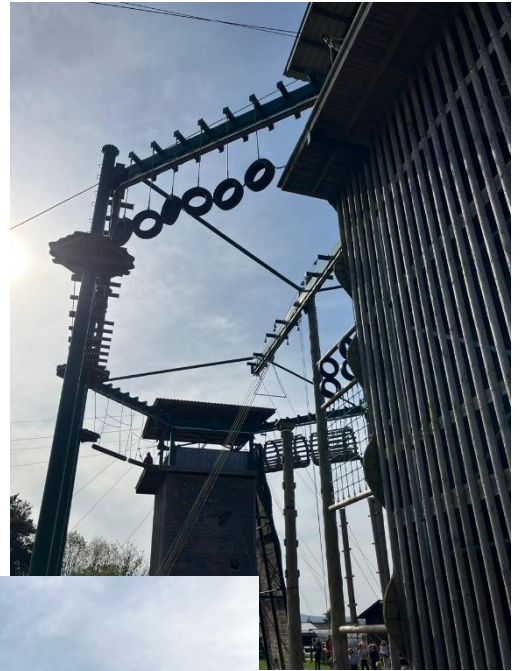
