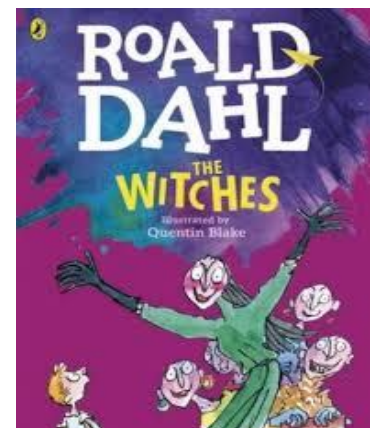
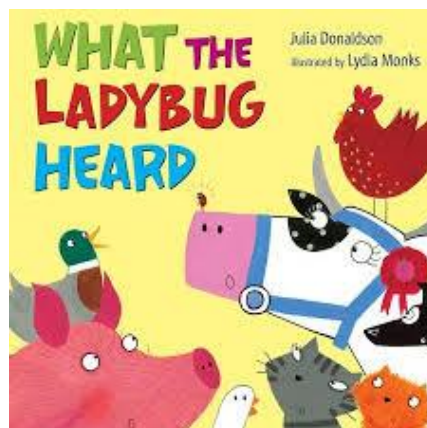
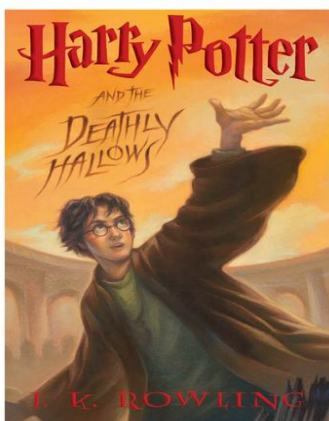
Poster Competition
