- White/black/grey socks

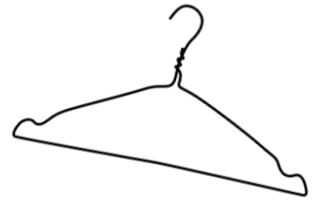
Jewellery is not to be worn and no makeup including nail varnish. Earrings; one piercing in each ear and studs only. Newly pierced ears will have to be taped.
