Cleaning Hours - Work Schedule

12.5 hrs per week, term time + 4 weeks periodic cleaning = 49.23 weeks per year.

5 days a week, 2.5 hrs per day cleaning

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday ideally between hours of 3.00-6.00pm but there may be flexibility in times i.e. early morning start for the right candidate after a trial period.

Caretaker - Work Schedule

5 hrs per week, term time + 4 weeks periodic caretaking = 49.23 weeks per year.

5 hrs per week 1 hr a day or can be accumulated depending on need. Caretaking role can be done before or after the cleaning depending on the daylight hours and time of year.

Potential for more hrs to be claimed if demand arises and time of year. Can be reviewed plus 4 weeks periodic caretaking in holidays.

Hours: Total of 17.5 hrs across both roles

- Willingness to gain knowledge of basic plumbing, electrical and decorating repair procedures.
- Willingness to gain knowledge of health and safety procedure and precautions.
- Willingness to gain awareness of COSHH regulations.
- Willingness to use relevant equipment.
- Ability to relate well to children and adults.
